

## Accommodations at MSP

The Morgan Scott Project building houses the MSP Offices, the Food Bank, the Thrift Store, and summer work groups. The facility is AIR CONDITIONED and very comfortable. This is a shared space serving many volunteers and clients. During office hours, the office is staffed with volunteers who answer the phone and assist clients. After business hours, please keep the front door locked and ask anyone who needs help to return during business hours. The office also has WI-FI and outlets for plugging in your electronics. There is a phone for emergency use. Cell phone coverage can be a bit spotty, but there are “hot spots” on the property. Verizon has quite good coverage.

There are two “private” dormitory type rooms. Generally, one is for men and one for women. Each room has bunk beds and will sleep 9 people on bunks. There is additional space on the floor for air mattresses if needed. In addition to the two rooms, there is space that may be used during the night hours to spread out – but your belongings must be stored in the dorm rooms during the day.

There are is one restroom for women with 2 showers and 2 toilets, and another restroom with 2 men’s showers and 2 toilets, plus an additional toilet and shower room available for your use. Restrooms are stocked with toilet paper, cleaning products, and cleaning towels. Please keep all personal items in your room. There is a clothesline available and a washer/dryer for you to use if needed. Paper towels are available for hand drying, but to be much more environmentally friendly, please use your personal hand towel.

The kitchen is cozy and well stocked with the basics – coffee makers, a grill, pots and pans, baking dishes, utensils, and dishes, plastic table ware – please reuse throughout your week and plastic cups (put your name on and reuse) will be available. It is recommended everyone bring a water bottle. There is no dishwasher and recycling is problematic. If your group wants to recycle (we encourage you to do so!) you will need to take the recycled items with you when you leave. Recycling is not available in the Deer Lodge area.

If your group would like to bring snacks/beverages (pop is not provided), there is storage space available for you.

There is a nice porch area with several picnic tables for meals outside if you’d like and an inside dining/meeting room with seating (cozy) for up to 24 people. Outside there is a lovely front porch for relaxing and a fire pit for evening campfires stocked with firewood.
