

## WHAT SHOULD I BRING?

### NECESSITIES:

Work Clothes-Shirts and pants must be worn at all time at the worksite (remember that some of them may not be usable after the job is done). This is mainly for safety reasons. We recommend wearing hard-soled shoes at the worksite.

Play shoes

Light Jacket or rain poncho, sweatshirt or sweater

Personal Toilet Items-towels, wash cloths, shower shoes, soap, facial tissues, insect repellent, and sunscreen

Pillow, sleeping bag, blanket (mattresses are provided)

Work gloves

Hammer, nail apron, tape measure, pencil

Coolers, water jugs

Medical Release Forms and Waivers

Please label all personal possessions for your convenience.

### Optional Items:

Hat or cap with broad brim

Flashlight

Camera and film

Personal Tools (well marked)

Bathing suit

Favorite songs or devotion

Paper and Pen or pencil

Musical instruments

Bible

Stereos, TV, valuables, such as jewelry, and excess money.
